

H1N1 Update - Partial School Closing

Dear AISB Community,

We have been directed by the Romanian Health Authorities to close the entire Secondary School, grades 6 – 12 immediately due to several newly reported cases of H1N1. The Secondary School will be closed beginning Friday, November 6 through next week. School will resume on Monday, November 16. All teachers, staff and administrators who are healthy will be at school during the school day to continue the education of all students through the use of online teaching tools such as Moodle, phone calls, Skype and emails. Secondary School students are expected to work from home and keep their work and progress up to date through next week.

There have been no reported cases of H1N1 in the Elementary School so the Health Authorities have encouraged us to continue the Elementary School as scheduled. They view AISB as two distinct schools: Elementary School and Secondary School. Therefore until there are confirmed cases of H1N1 in the Elementary School we will keep this area of the school open.

Soccer Tournament

The Health Department officials said the tournament must be cancelled immediately. This unfortunate decision requires all visiting athletes to return home on the next available flights Friday, November 6. Athletes who are staying with host families should return to the AISB as scheduled in the morning, with their suitcases packed, to await their flights home. You will be contacted by the coach of the students you are hosting sometime this evening (Thursday).

Group Events are cancelled

All large group events are cancelled until further notice, such as the Soccer Tournament and tomorrow's Middle School Activity evening and after school activities in the Elementary School.

Student Study Materials

If your child does not have all of their books and course materials they will need to make arrangements to pick them up from the school. Please either pick up these materials

yourself or have a driver do so tomorrow. If a student is healthy they are allowed to come to school but only long enough to get their books and course materials and then return home.

Travel for AISB Students

We are awaiting a decision about whether our students can travel next week for the MUN and Speech and Debate Tournament. You will be informed of this as soon as we are notified.
